- Intercollegiate Research Competition on the topic ‘Impact of Demonetisation’’: 1 team of 3 students participated in this competition organised at Gurunanak College, Sion.
- Intercollegiate Research Competition: 1 team of 5 students participated in the Intercollegiate Research Competition Mathema held at K. E. S. Shroff College, Kandivali and won 1st Prize.
- Exploring the World of Research: One day seminar on “Exploring the World of Research” was conducted by Dr. Arvind Luhar. It was an intercollegiate seminar arranged for M. Com students. The purpose of the seminar was to acquaint the participants with the intricacies of research.
- Research Paper Writing - Styles and Techniques: Session on ‘Research Paper Writing’ conducted by Mr. Kuldeep Sharma for students and faculty.
- Intellectual Property Rights Seminar: Seminar on Intellectual Property Rights conducted by Mr. Zameer Nathani (UFO Movies).
- Introduction to IPR- Exploring the World of Intellectual Property: An intercollegiate webinar on “Introduction to IPR- Exploring the World of Intellectual Property” conducted by Dr. Mrs. Nilima Chandaramani, Principal, Nari Gursahani Law College. The webinar focused on the intricacies of intellectual property rights, the various types and how one can explore the world of creation and invention staying well within the domains of intellectual property rights. The speaker focused on not only the rights, but also the responsibilities of the creator or inventor of works.
- Panel Discussion on “Can India produce world class researchers”’: The Research Cell along with Teach Us organised a national level talk series called “Let’s talk Education” on this topic which focused on the way ahead for research in India and the challenges that researchers face. Eminent personalities Dr, Harish Kumar Purohit- Director, PTVA’s Institute of Management, Ms. Debolina Dutta- Professor of Practice, IIM Bangalore and Dr. Hemant Chandak-Professor, GSSAC College participated in this discussion and contributed immensely with their vast experience and proficiency.
- 2-day National Level Faculty Development Programme- Online Resource and Academic Integrity: The sessions were conducted by Dr. Santosh C.H., University Librarian, Central University of Haryana.
Day 1 of the webinar series focused on the effective use of open access resources and the tools and techniques that one could employ for the same. Day 2 covered the dos and don’ts of plagiarism and a strategic, tactful approach to avoid plagiarism. 82 participants joined the program on both days.
- AVISHKAR: The college has been participating every year in Avishkar a research convention organized by the University of Mumbai. The competition aims at developing a research culture and scientific temper among students, scholars and teachers from under – graduate to doctoral level in Maharashtra. The college faculty have been mentoring students for this activity with the aim of creating a love for research among undergraduate and post graduate students. Over the years teams have presented projects in the fields of Humanities, Commerce, Engineering and Technology.
