

FREESHIP POLICY

Cosmopolitan's Valia C.L. College of Commerce & Valia L.C. College of Arts

Valia College is committed to the goal of supporting socio-economically weak but academically meritorious students in the area of higher education. In order that no student is denied the opportunity due to financial inadequacy, the college makes available to students' scholarships from both government and non-government bodies including individual donors and corporate houses. Scholarships are given to students based on need and merit. The procedure of grant of scholarship by the management is clearly defined in the scholarship policy of the institution.

Policy

The college shall make all efforts to contact donors and request them to provide scholarships to needy and deserving students.

The college shall make all efforts to create awareness among students about the various scholarships available as well as the application process and eligibility criteria.

In the case of government scholarships, the college shall follow the eligibility criteria as per government policies.

In the case of all other scholarships the eligibility criteria will be as laid down by the college scholarship committee in consultation with the donor wherever applicable.

In the case of scholarships given by corporate houses the eligibility will be as per the policies of the corporate house.

The college will constitute a selection committee comprising of faculty and administrative staff.

This Committee will be responsible for inviting, collecting and scrutinizing applications and in consultation with the principal recommending cases for consideration.

The decision of the committee will be final and binding.

Only one scholarship will be awarded per student, per academic year.

Scholarship will be either directly credited to the bank accounts of students by the granting authority or in case where the amount is credited to the institution, the same is immediately disbursed to the students via cheque.

Scholarship awarded may be withdrawn at any given point in time and disciplinary action will be initiated against the student, if it is found that the candidate has submitted incorrect details/particulars in their application, or is found guilty of malpractice, misconduct, and violation of college policies, rules and regulations.

Other things being equal preference will be given to female students as well as disadvantaged sections of society.
