The action taken report based on the discussion and suggestions given in the feedback is prepared by the Head of the Institution and corrective actions initiated.










Q. 3 Did the curriculum fulfill your Expectations?

Q. 4 The Syllabus was directly related to enhancing practical and professional competencies.






Q.3 The entire syllabus is completed in time?







Members discussed the report submitted by Principal Dr. Shobha Menon containing the analysis of feedback from all stakeholders.

No suggestions came from the alumni and the teachers as per the report.

The feedback received from the students clearly stated that they would want more industrial exposure and updates on the latest developments made in their subject areas and would want more practical sessions for subjects like Information Technology, etc.

The feedback received from employers stated that the students would require to upgrade their communication and leadership skills along with developing their creativity.

These suggestions were discussed in the meeting and the following recommendations were made:

- 1. College to install projectors in each classroom and upgrade the computer systems to the latest softwares.
- 2. College to continue industrial visits for students in future to give them industry exposure, as were conducted before the onset of pandemic.
- 3. College to continue organizing guest lectures for students on amendments or recent developments made in the respective subject areas and continue with the skill development and creative writing workshops.
