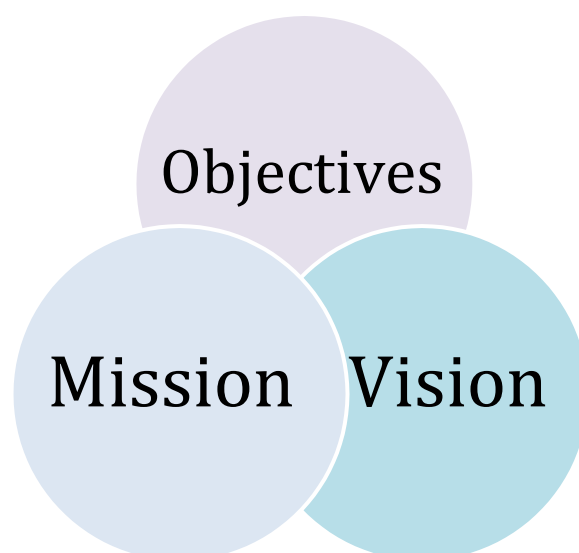

LIBRARY REPORT

The College has a spacious well-lit, air-conditioned library with number of facilities spanning over an area of 4500 sq.ft. The library is situated on the fourth floor of the college building. The library has a crucial role in providing information services as well as in research activities. It has a rich collection of more than 20000+ books of Aided and Self-finance courses and different types of periodicals like newspaper, journals, magazine are subscribed.

It has different sections like Book stack area, reading room, E-resource center, newspaper and periodical rack. Cleanliness and maintenance of the library is always given top priority. Library is automated with MICM software with full barcode technology to books and its patrons for quick circulation. It has also integrated a Footfall module in which user's attendance/footfalls are also automated.

Following are the facilities provided in the library:

- Reading Room – It has a seating capacity of more than 150 with separate arrangements for faculty and students.
- Home Lending - Students and faculties can borrow books from home lending counter. Generally, students and faculties are issued two books at a time for a period of one week.

- Cubicles for Faculty- Separate cubicles are available for faculty members for the purpose of brainstorming, study, and research.
- Research Corner – there is a separate area dedicated for research work by faculty members and students as well. The area is equipped with a desktop computer, printer, and several research related books.
- Reference Service - The library staff help the readers in searching for their reference books through software as well as in physical space. Readers are also provided with relevant documents in print and electronic form.
- E-Resource Centre- Library has a separate section in which 4 terminals are available for users can access N-List in which 6000+ e-journals & 799500+ e-books from different publishers are accessible to users. Library has installed DSpace-Institutional repository software in which question papers, syllabus etc. are maintained.
- Internet accessibility: Library has Wi-Fi access & it also provides power switches and more than 30 Ethernet cable nodes for internet access.
- Photocopying facility – Students and faculty members can avail the facility of photocopying in the library with the help of a multi- functional printer capable of printing, scanning, and photocopying.
- Library is under CCTV surveillance.
- Fire alarms and fire extinguishers are set up in the library.
- Annual Library Report is published in the college magazine Ira.
- Annual Book Display/Exhibitions is held on an annual basis. Staff and students get the opportunity to buy books for personal use as well as recommend books for the college through this exhibition. In the year 2022-23 book exhibition was conducted on 20th February 2023. Several book publishers and distributors participated in this exhibition.

Library Best practices:

- Current Awareness Service (CAS): Library has started its CAS via News articles related to IT, Economy, Finance, Education, Research etc. is scanned and send it to faculty on daily basis.
- Under the College Book Bank Scheme sets of books are distributed to needy and deserving students in various classes. During the year 2022-2023, 16 students were benefited by the Book Bank Scheme.
- Earn While You Learn Scheme: The Library operates an Earn-while-you-learn Scheme, in which college students are hired as interns to learn and perform various library tasks such as barcoding new books, taking stock, and checking records. This scheme allows students to gain experience in basic library operations while also earning a stipend. In the year 2022-23, a total of seventeen students benefitted from this scheme.
- Pick and Drop Book point : The Pick and Drop Book Point serves as a central location within the library where individuals can donate books. The library encourages everyone, faculty members, students, or staff, to take advantage of this platform and contribute to the circulation of knowledge within the institution. This unique feature allows anyone in the institution, to donate a book they do not require while also providing opportunities for others to freely pick up a book of their choice.
