Stakeholders' feedback are collected and analyzed at department level.

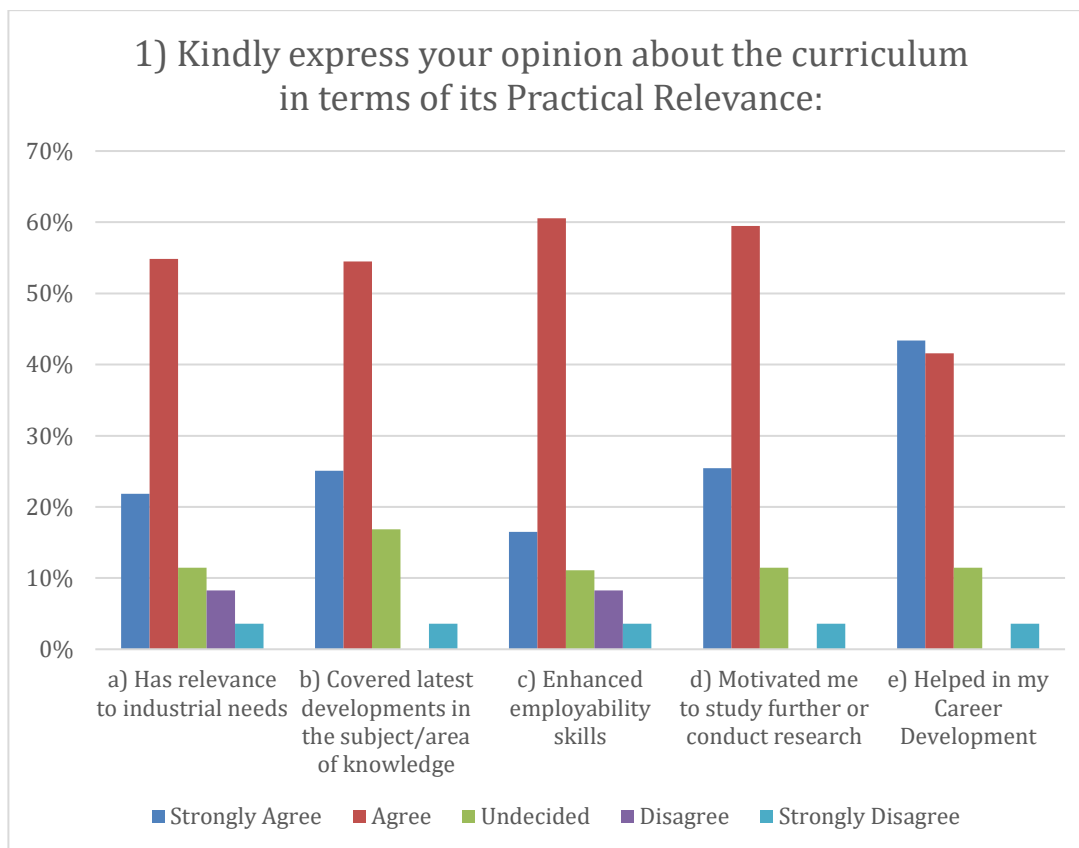
Overall analysis of the stakeholder feedback report is presented in Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) meeting.

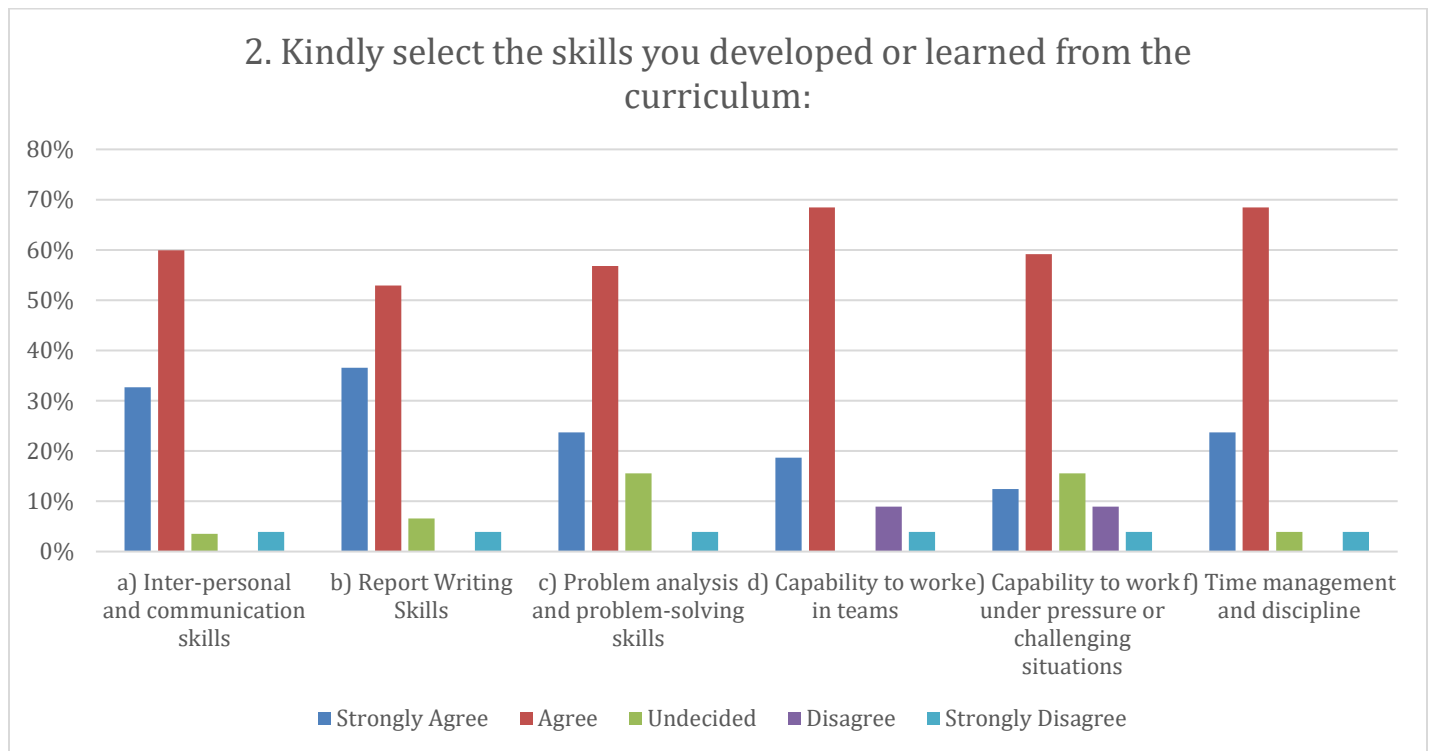

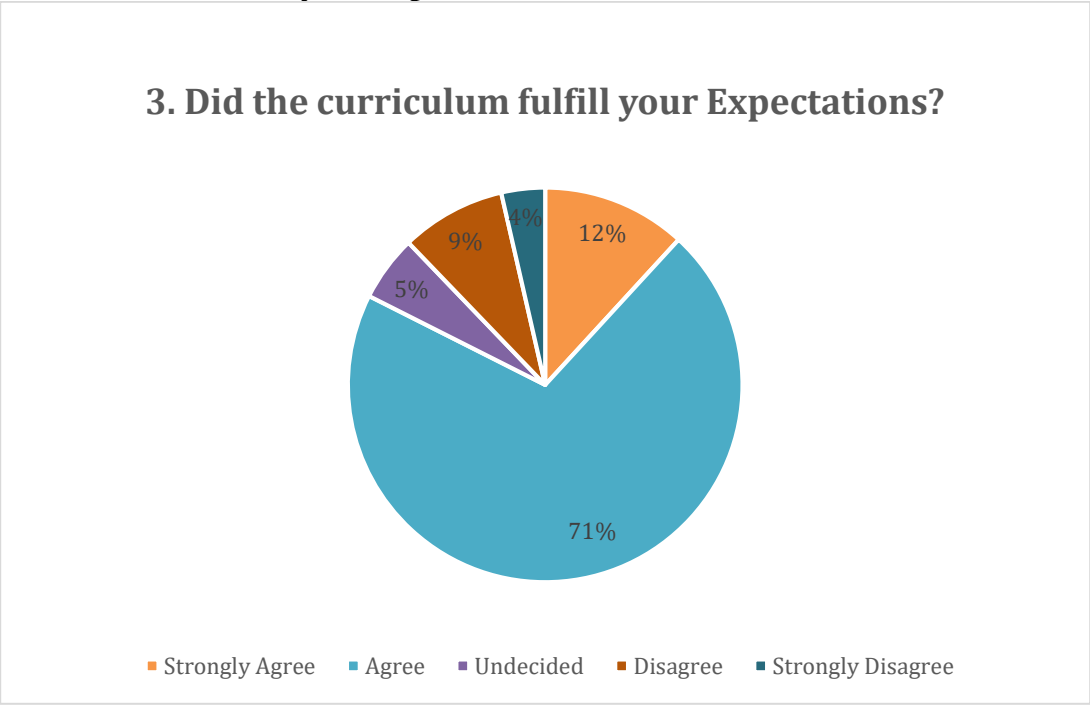

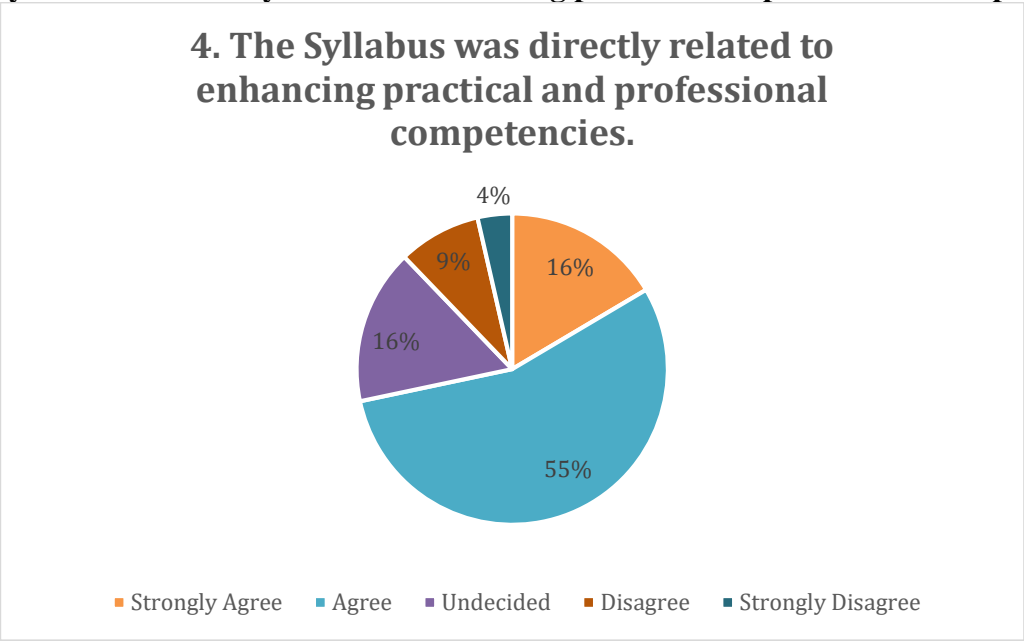

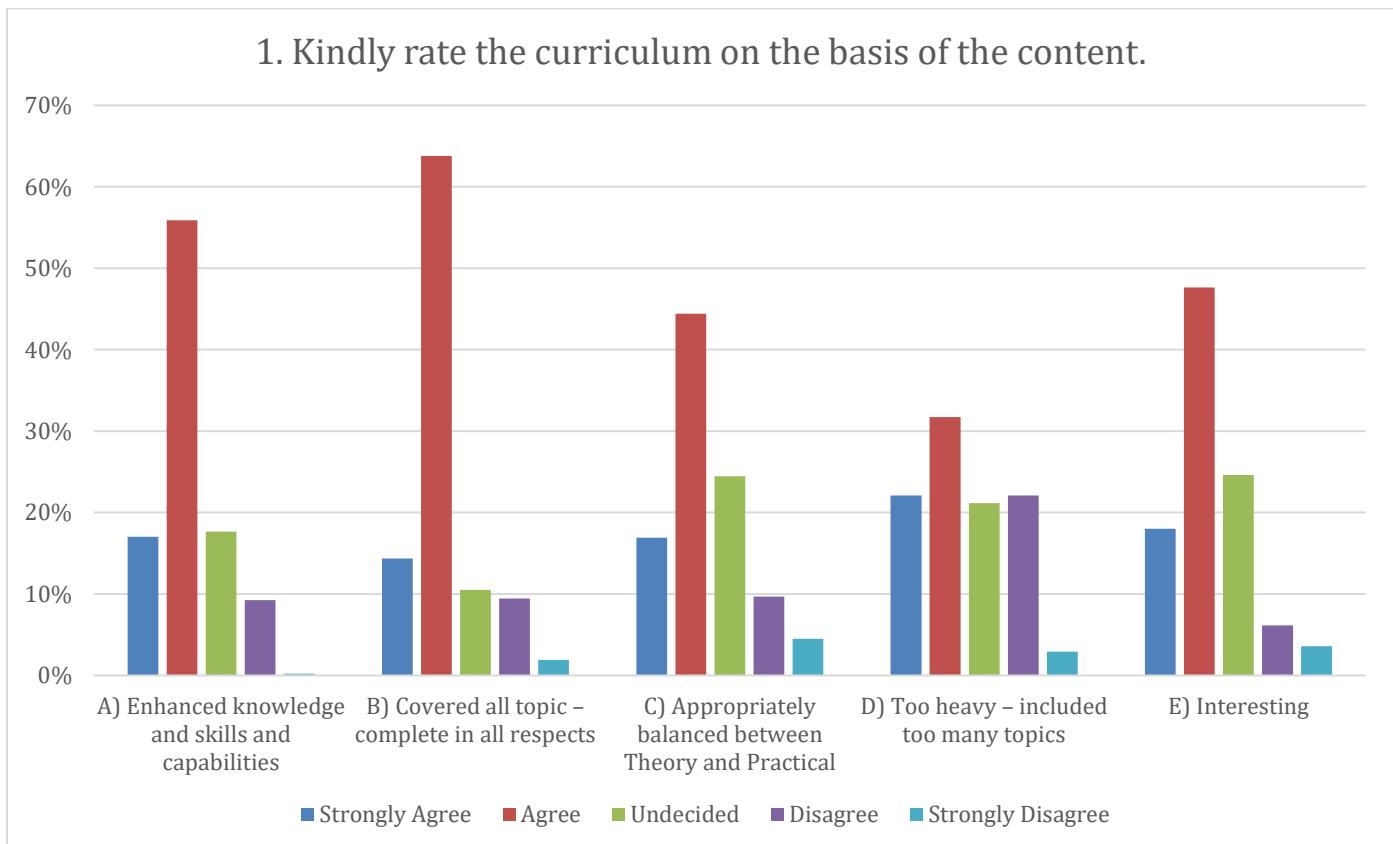

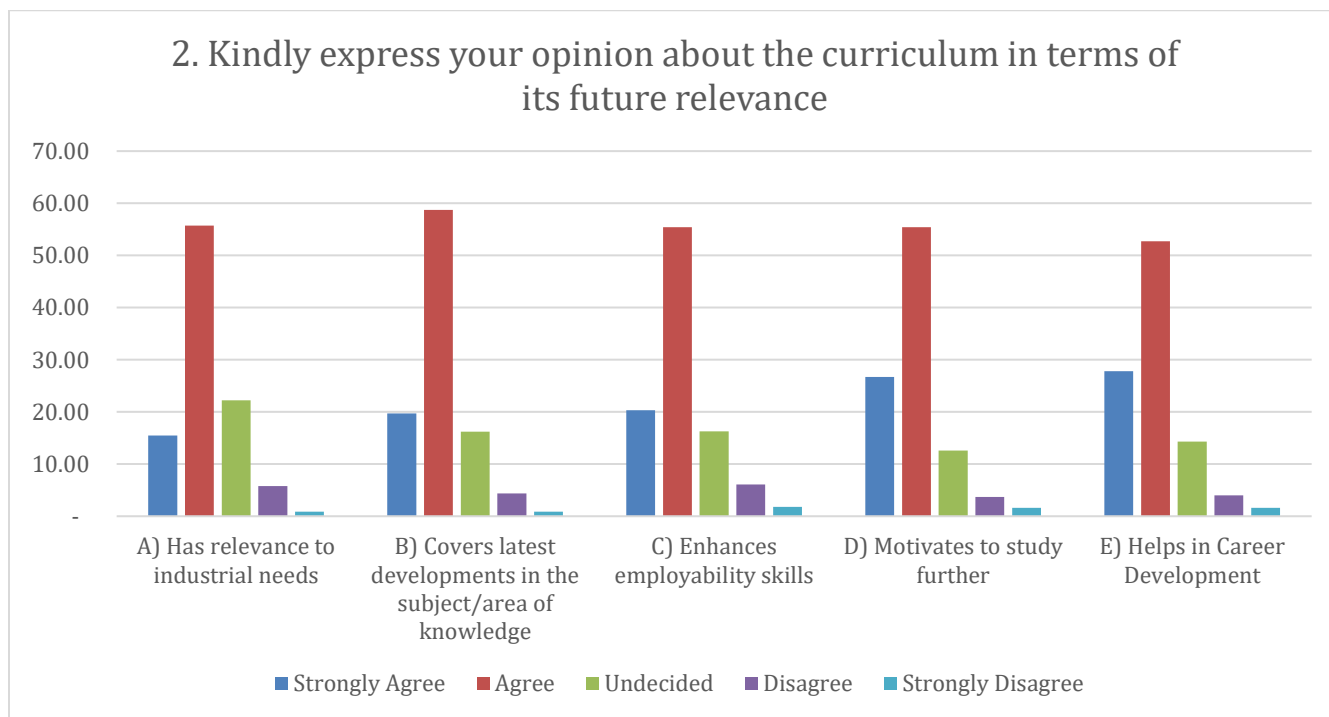

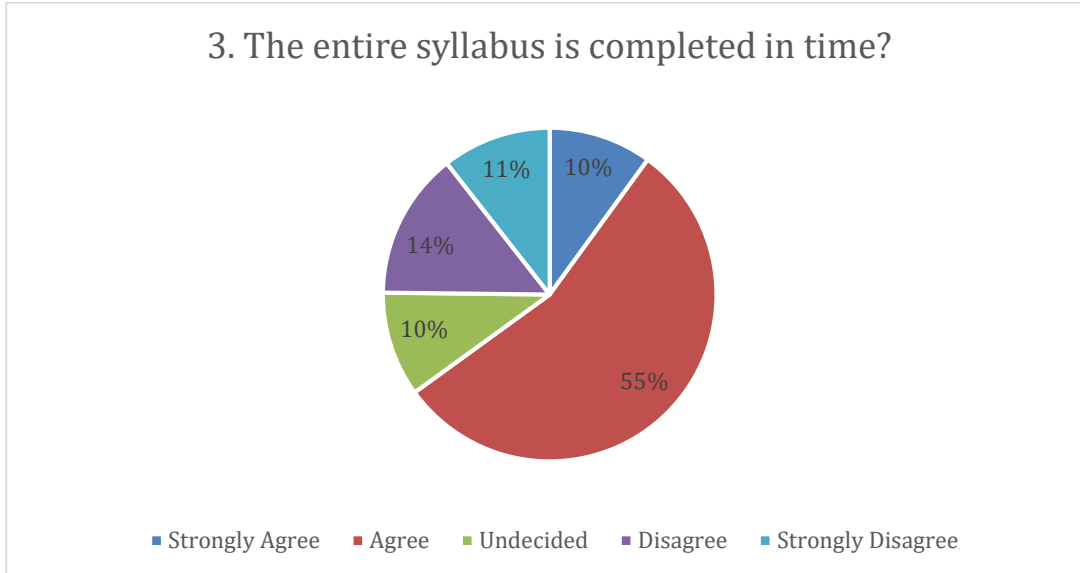

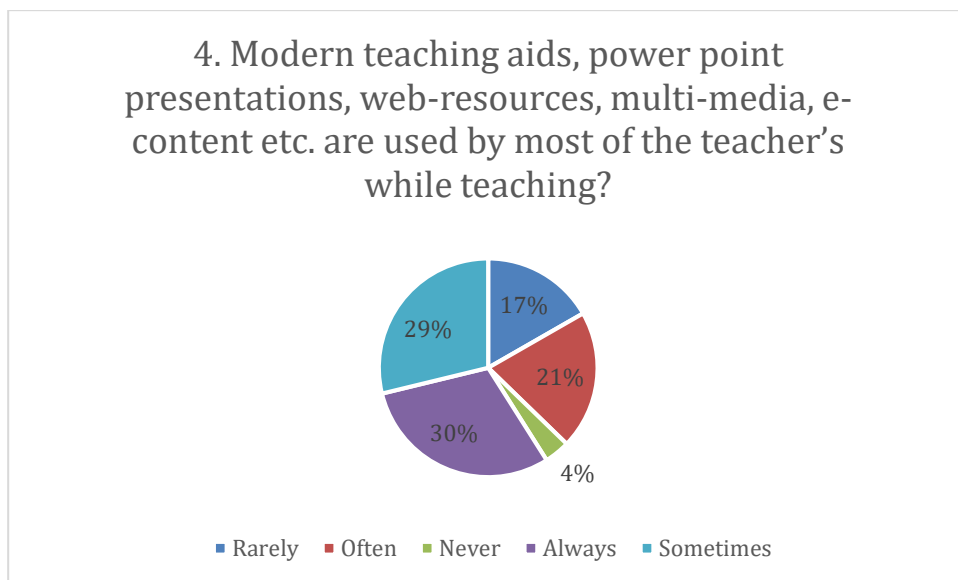

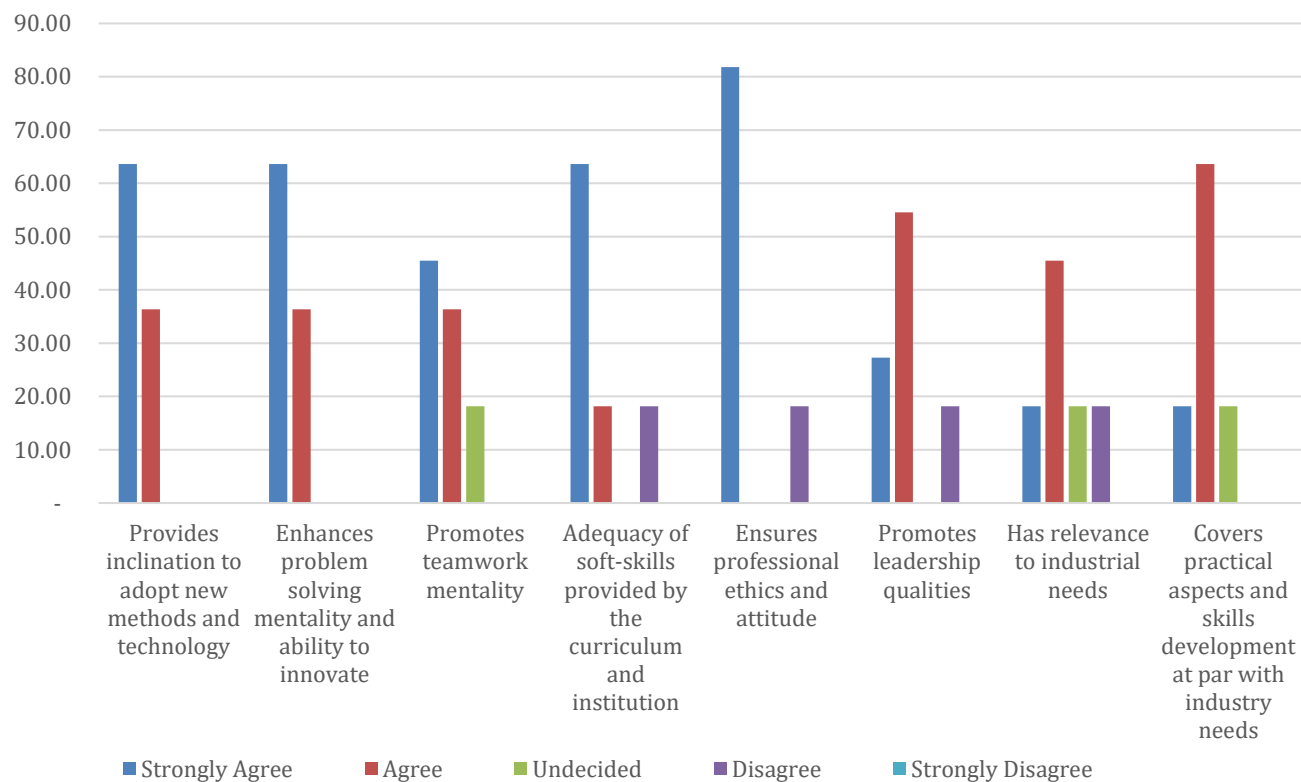

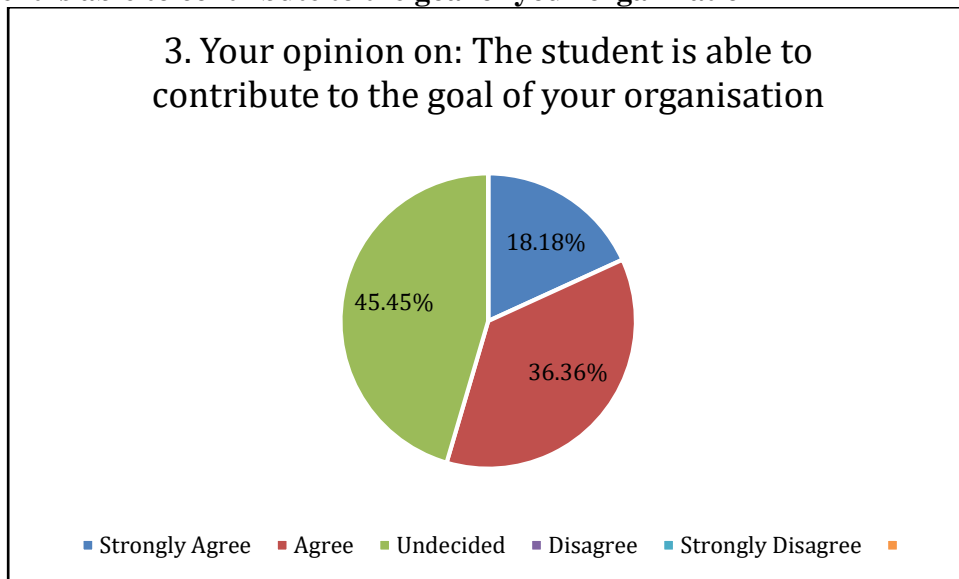

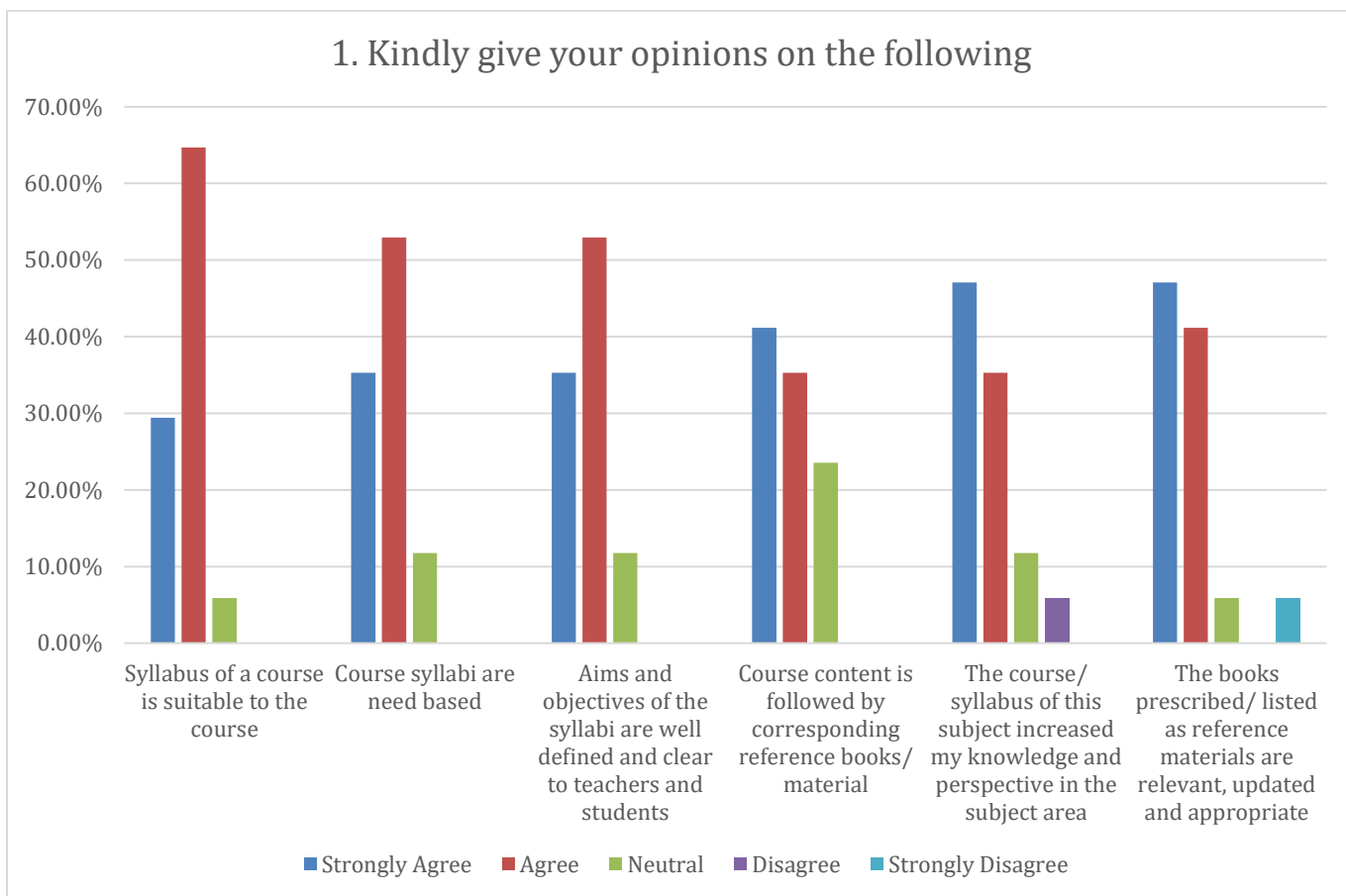
