- 3. Run for Leprosy Students learnt the vital importance of maintaining a healthy lifestyle, by participating in a physically strenuous activity they also realized their own thresholds of endurance.
- 4. Tree plantation drive on Earth Day In an urban landscape sadly starved of green spaces an activity such as this reiterated the need for saving and encouraging the creation of green spaces.
- 5. Samavesh a sports event for the differently abled Inclusivity and wholehearted acceptance of those that are generally viewed as the 'other' or as 'disabled 'can only be possible when one interacts in a non-judgmental environment that encourages the shedding of prejudices. By being a part of Samavesh students learnt invaluable life lessons that would not only make them better human beings but also prepare them for new workplaces which adopt an inclusivity policy.


